Statutes

Free translation of statutes

Article 1 : Constitution and name

The founding members constitute a non-profit association registered in France (“loi de 1901”):

European Photocatalysis Federation (EPF)

Article 2 : Aims

- Identify and bring together all actors in the field photocatalysis,
- Inventory of photocatalysis-related trades
- Definition and drawing up of a professional code,
- Contribution to the definition of standards and tests for photocatalytic material and devices,
- Representations of the the interests of members, at an international level,
- Publication of white papers on specific questions,
- Relations with other organizations for the development of photocatalysis,
- Research projects for the development of photocatalysis,
